They chose Puerto Rico Discovery Day to highlight the parallel between the "sale" of Spanish-held Puerto Rico to the U.S. for \$20 million under the Treaty of Paris in 1898, and the intentions of the Spanish to endanger 200,000 human lives and destroy farm lands, water sources and ecologically valuable habitats and endangered species, in the words of the young students.
